## WHAT IS THE IRB?

The Institutional Review Board for the Protection of Human Subjects (IRB) is responsible for the review of all research activity that involves human subjects that is conducted on or off campus by faculty, staff, or students, or others seeking to conduct research at the University of Scrittenton operations and scope are required and guided by the Code of Federal Regulatoric CFR 4@as amended Activities governed by this regulation and the University Spolicies and procedures include research, development, and related activities which would normally be construed as biological, behavioral, or psychological investigations involving human subjects.

When reviewing research proposals, the IRB is primarily interested in safegutaned inights and well-being of the human subject and in assessing the ethical implications of the proposed procedures As described in The Belmont Repolate following ethical principles and their translation into actions erve as an additional guide foreth RB's review of research activities
